

## FUNDING INFORMATION CONSIDERATIONS

Before looking for funding, here are some points to consider.

<b>Will this be a conference, workshop or seminar?</b>
<b>Is this a one-off event or part of a series?</b>
<b>Is the event part of a research project?</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- To disseminate results?</li> <li>- To start a new collaboration?</li> </ul>
<b>Do you have a co-convenor from another institution?</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Could we ask this other institution for funding?</li> </ul>
<b>How many people do you expect to attend?</b>
<b>Will speakers/contributors be coming from overseas?</b>
<b>Will the theme be national or international?</b>
<b>Will undergraduate students be invited?</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- As delegates or presenting papers/taking part?</li> </ul>
<b>Will graduate taught students be invited?</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- As delegates or presenting papers/taking part?</li> </ul>
<b>Will graduate research students be invited?</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- As delegates or presenting papers/taking part?</li> </ul>
<b>Would it be possible for sponsors to attend all or only part of the event?</b>
<b>Would a sponsor be able to take part in the event? (As a speaker/delegate?)</b>
<b>Will delegates pay a fee?</b>
<b>Will there be different rates for academics, students, practitioners/commercial sector?</b>
